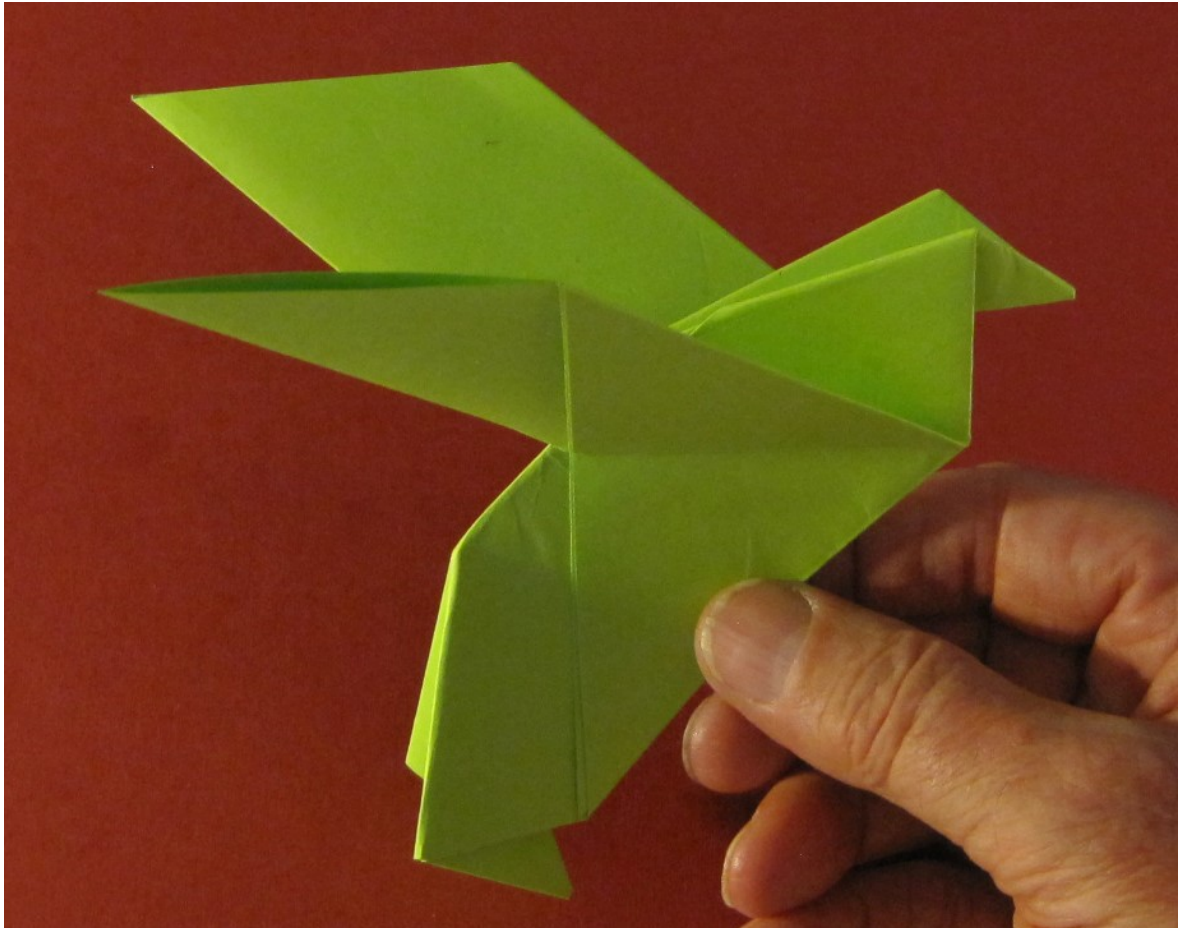


1. How to make a Peace Dove

Peace comes from working together.

So find a partner who is different from yourself - different age, religion, culture, race etc.



2. Chose Roles

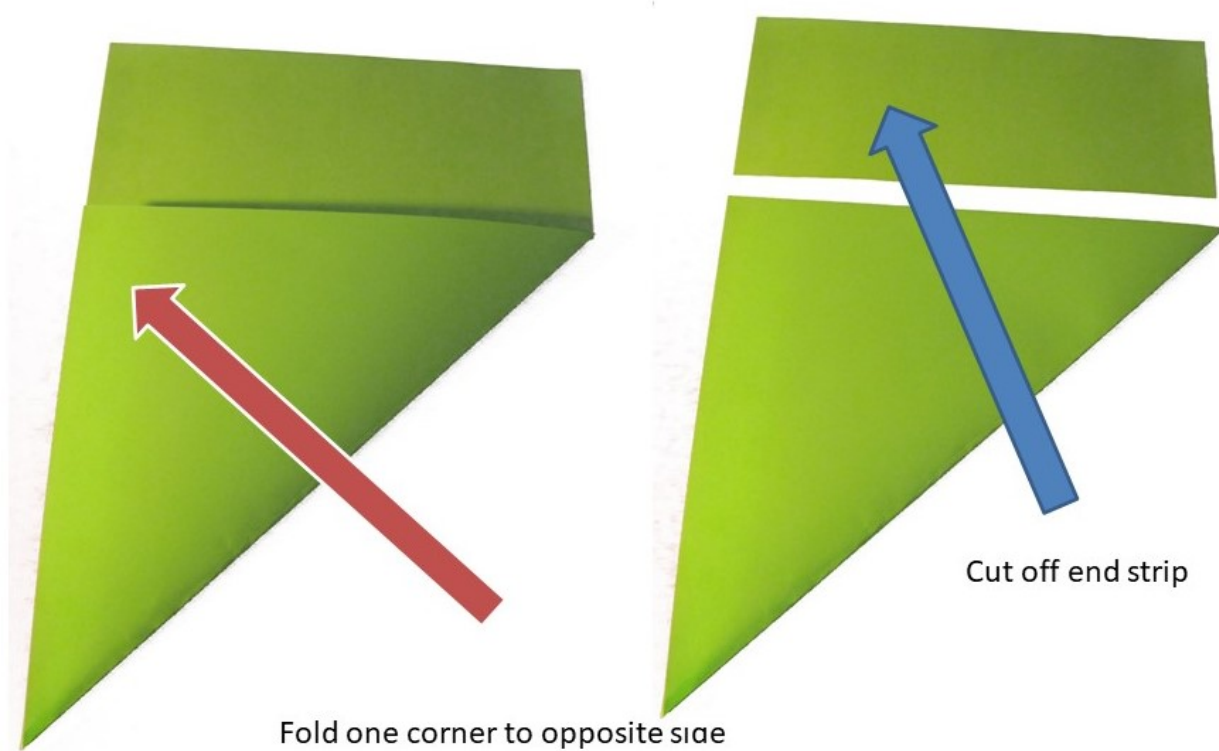
One person will see pictures and read instructions while the other makes the dove.

Then you will swap roles.

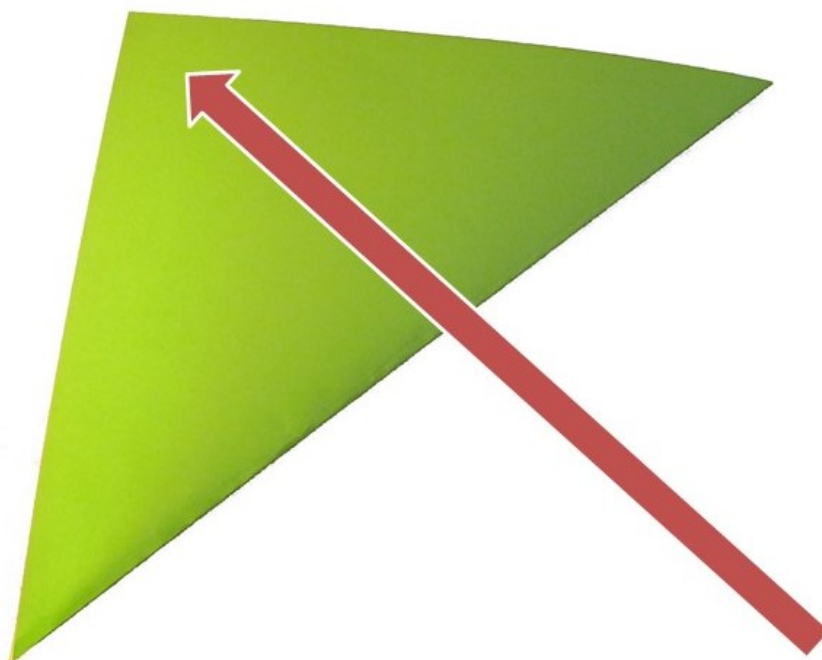
Decide who will make the first dove.

3. If using A4 paper



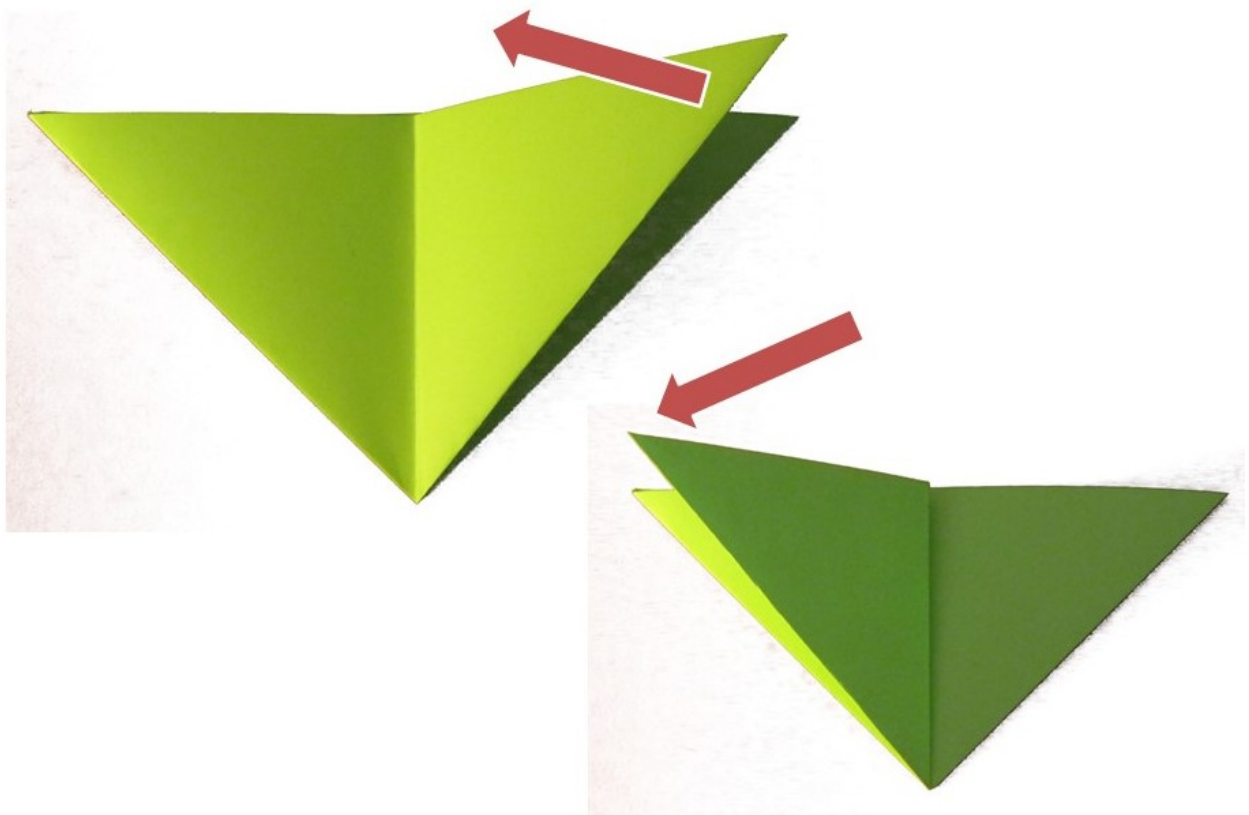
4. If start with square, fold diagonally



- 5. Fold it again corner to corner**

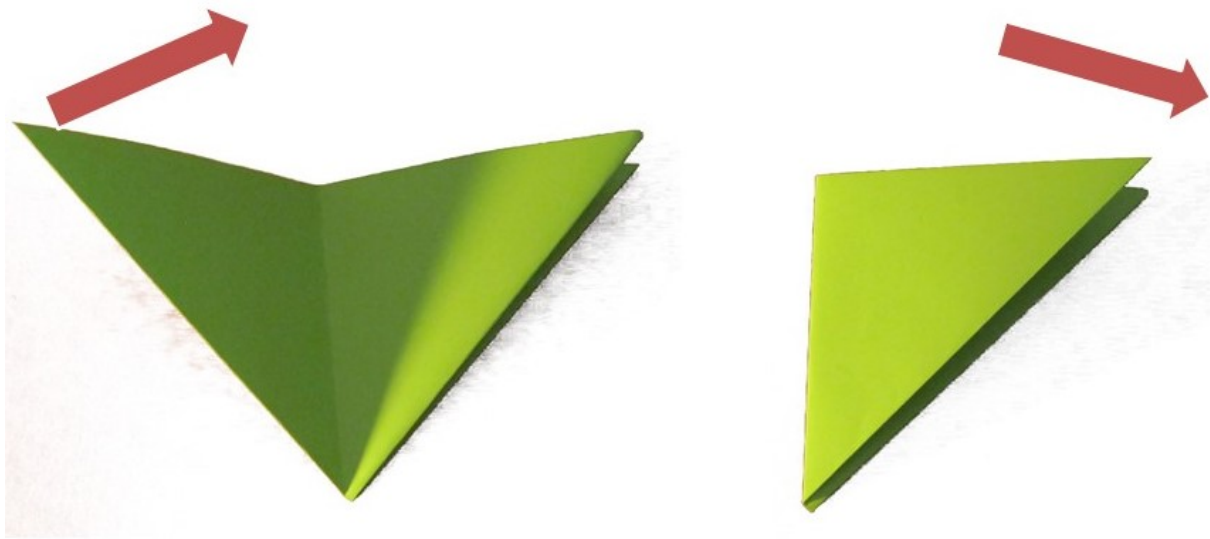


- 6. Lift one flap and fold to opposite corner**

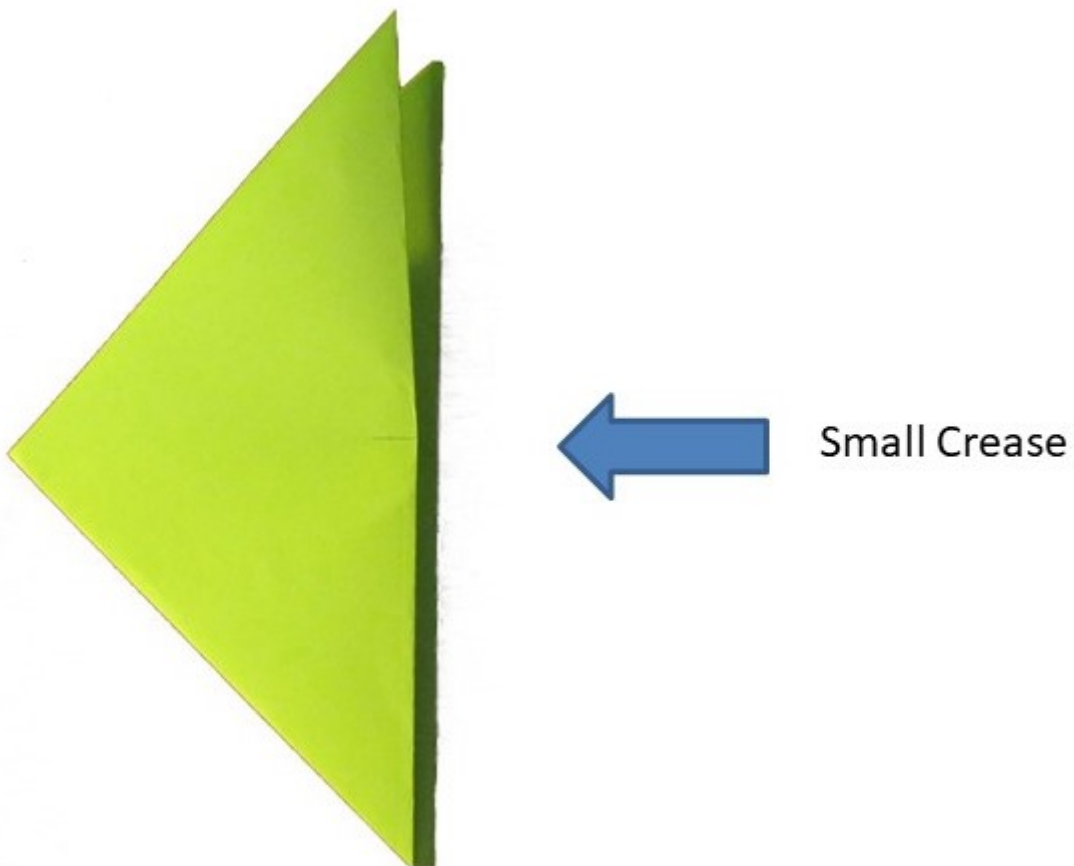

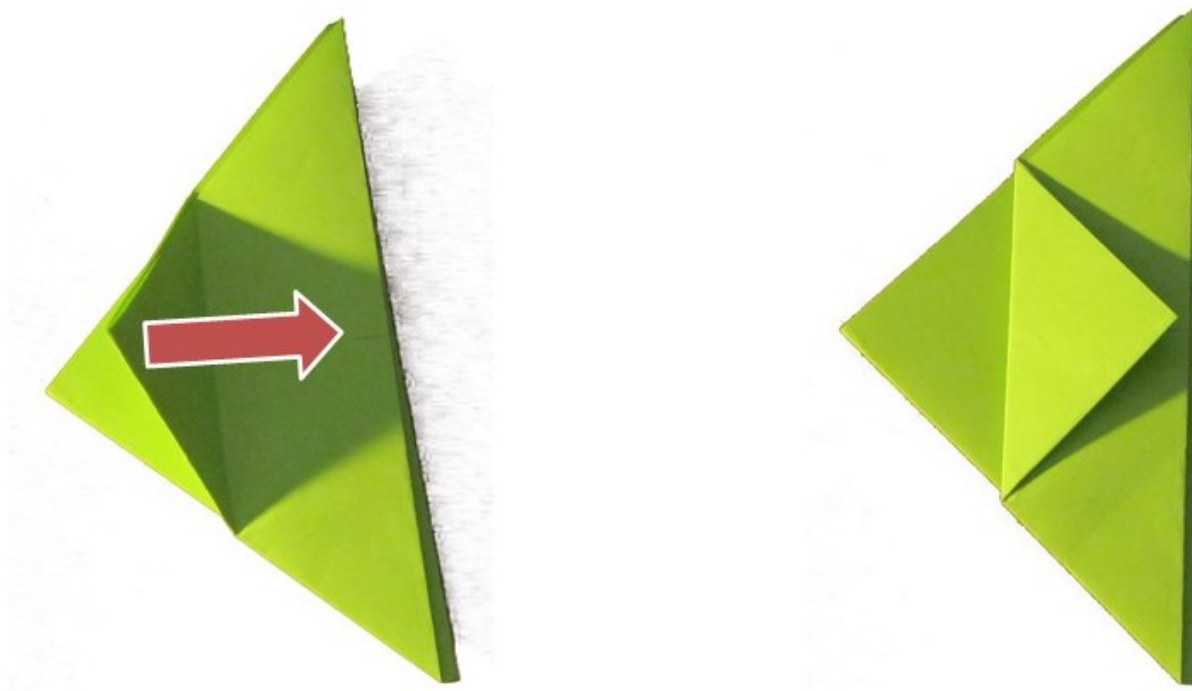
7. Turn paper over and repeat



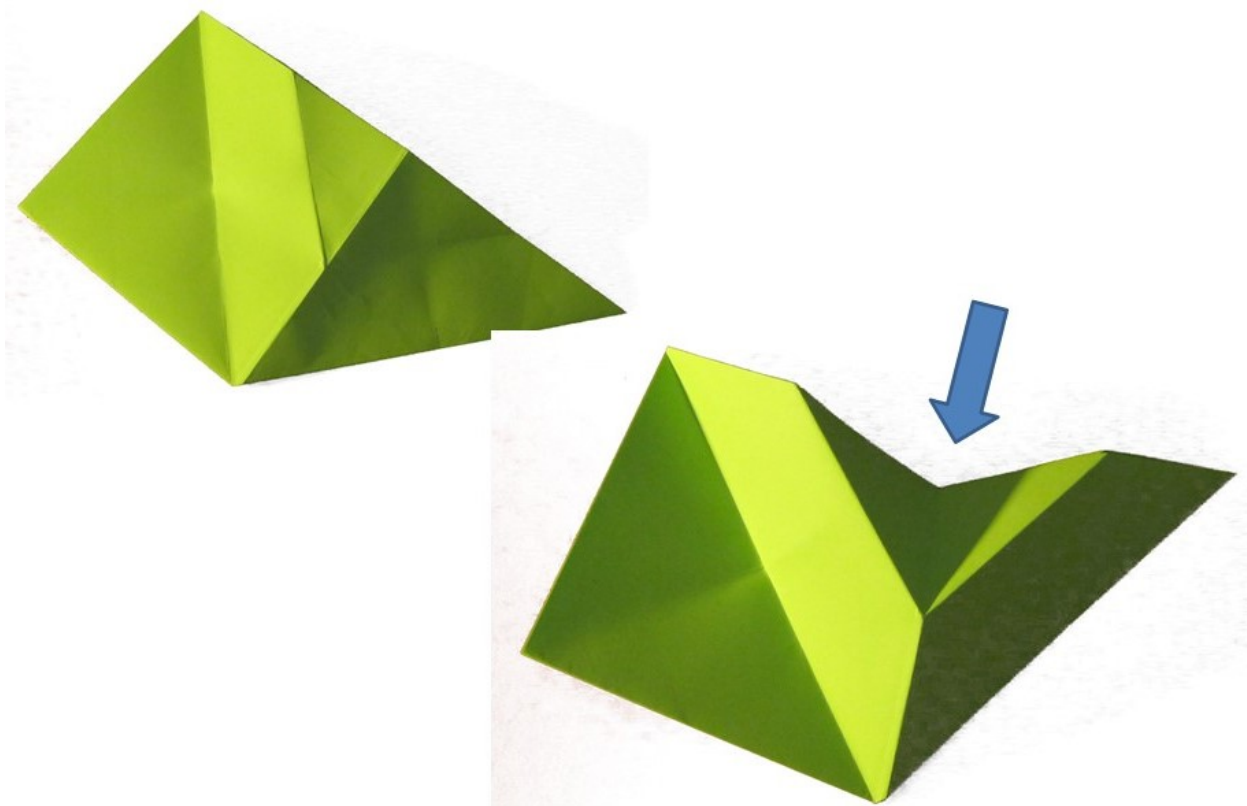
8. Find middle of long side by folding and creasing slightly



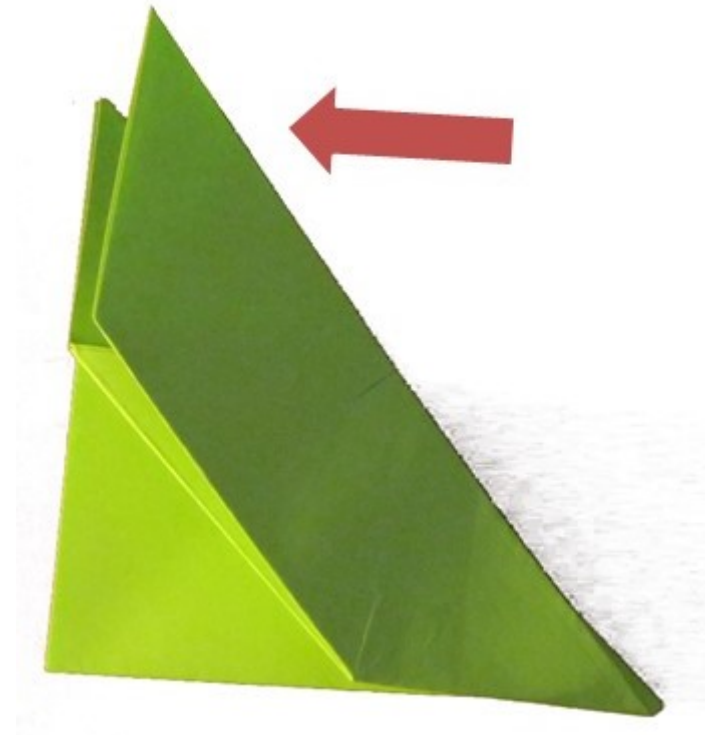
- 9. Lift one big corner and fold to crease mark**



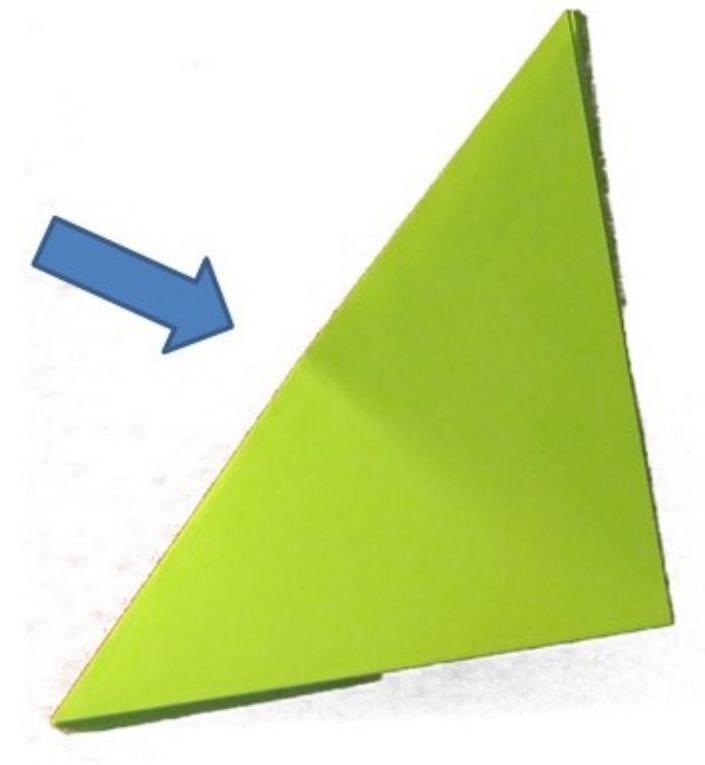
- 10. Open out flap and invert the V fold**



11. Close the flap and crease well



12. Turn paper over and find crease mark

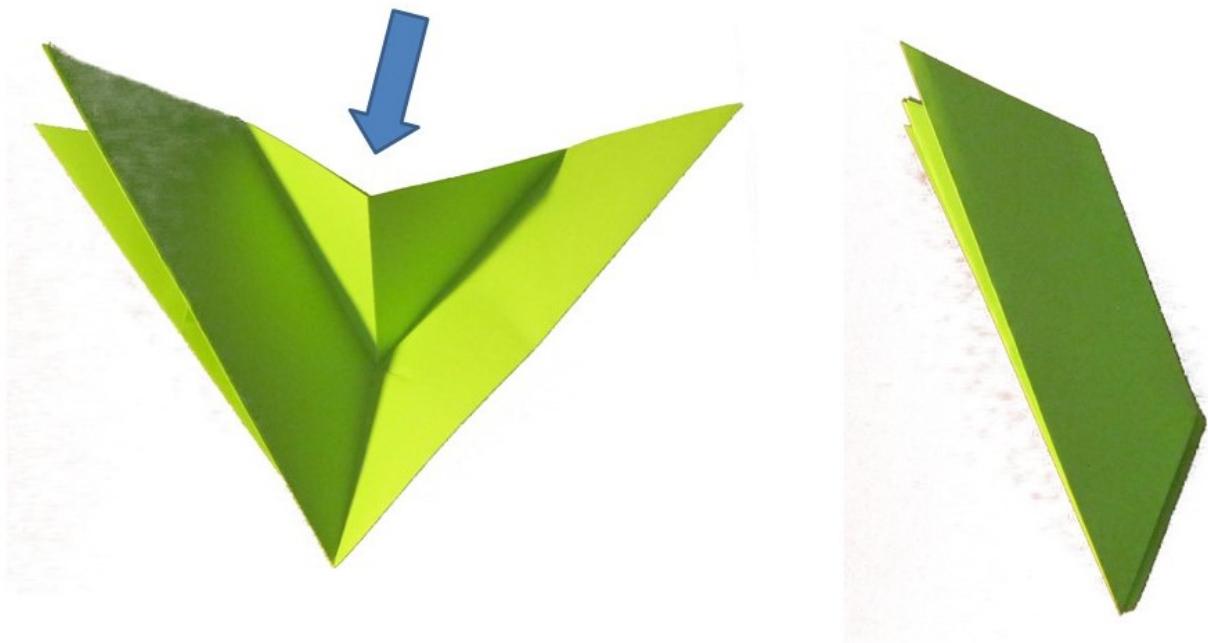

13. Lift up big corner and fold to crease mark



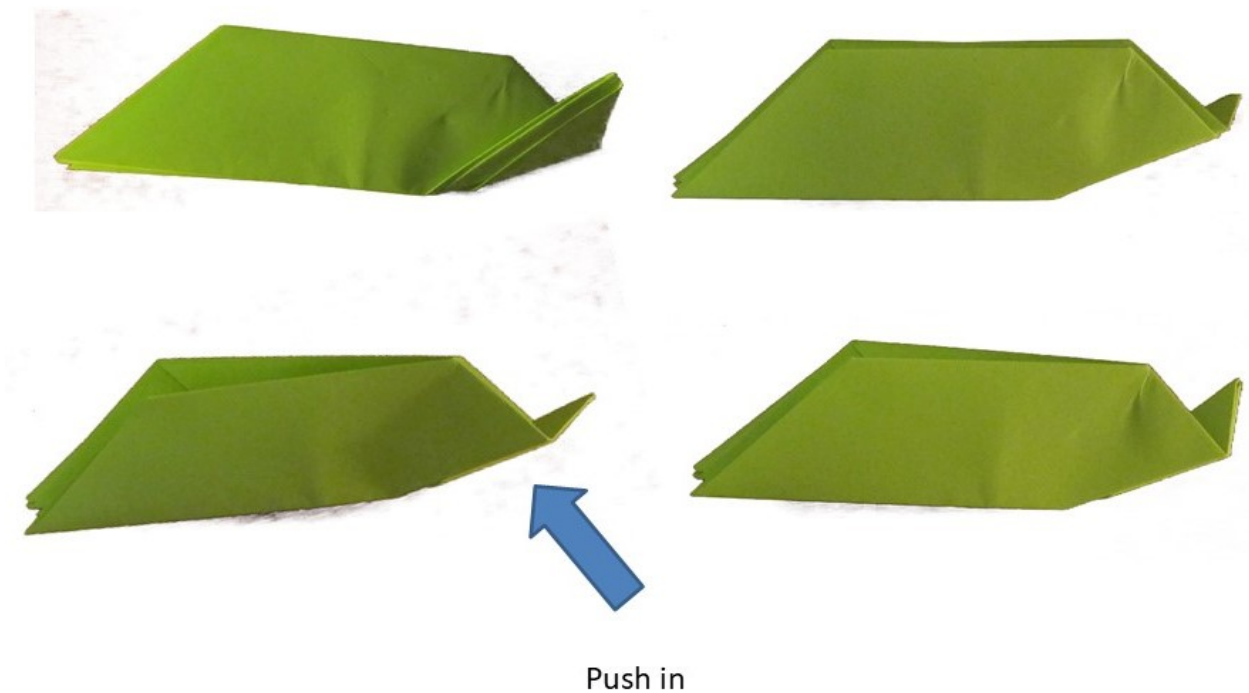
14. Open flap and invert V as before, then close flap



15. Find the “closed end” of the model and put on right

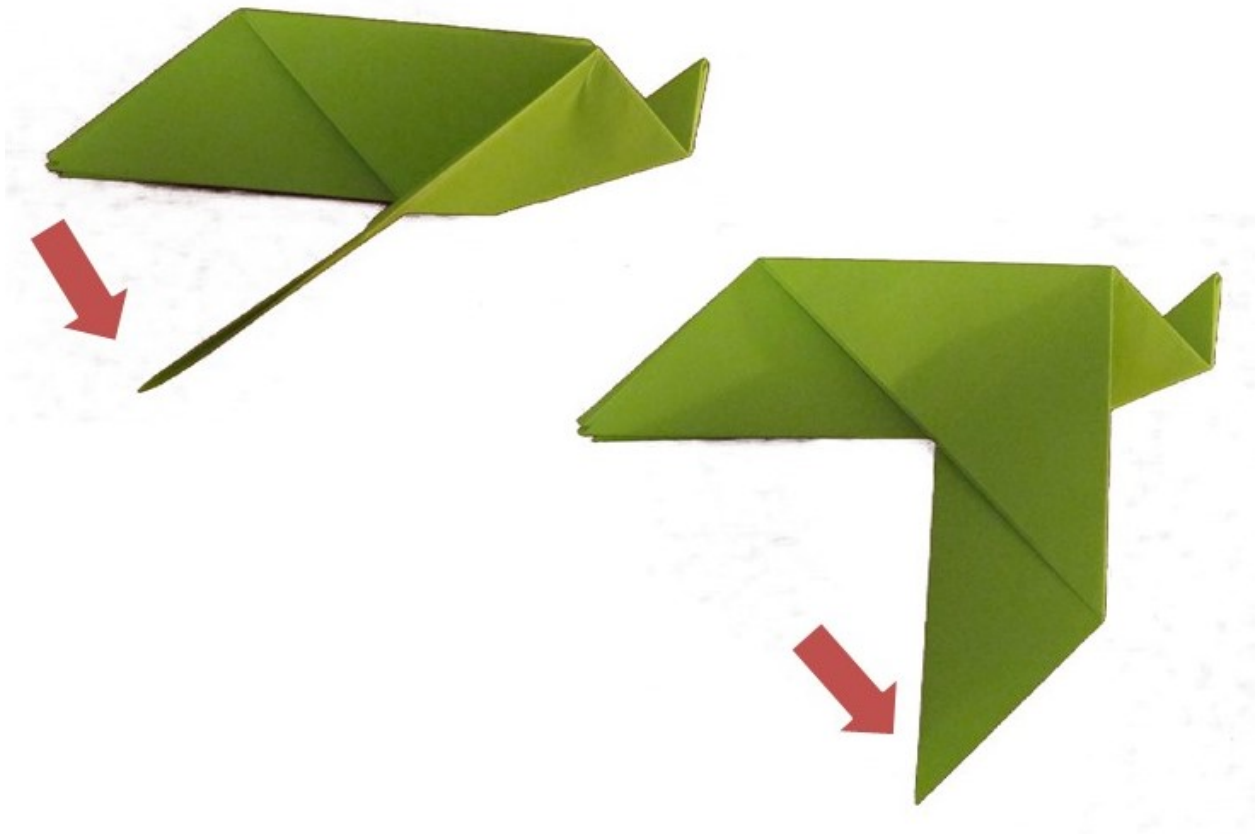


**16. Fold closed end up and down.
Then push in to make beak**

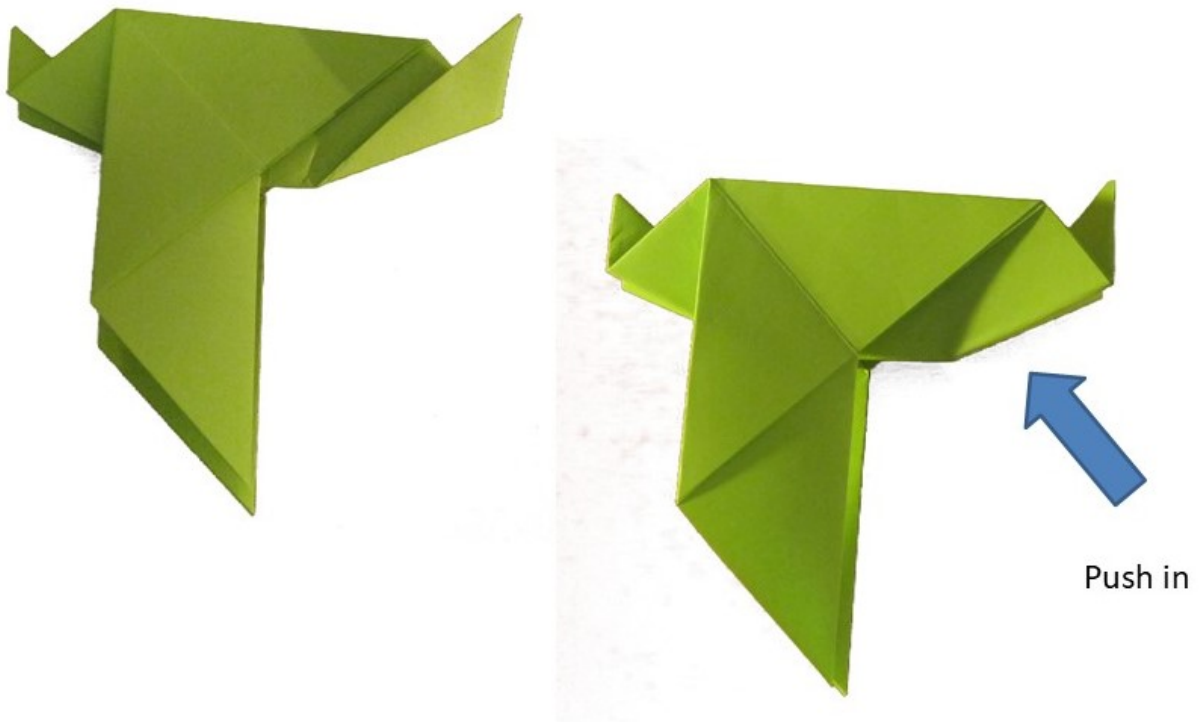

17. Lift side to make wing. Repeat on other side



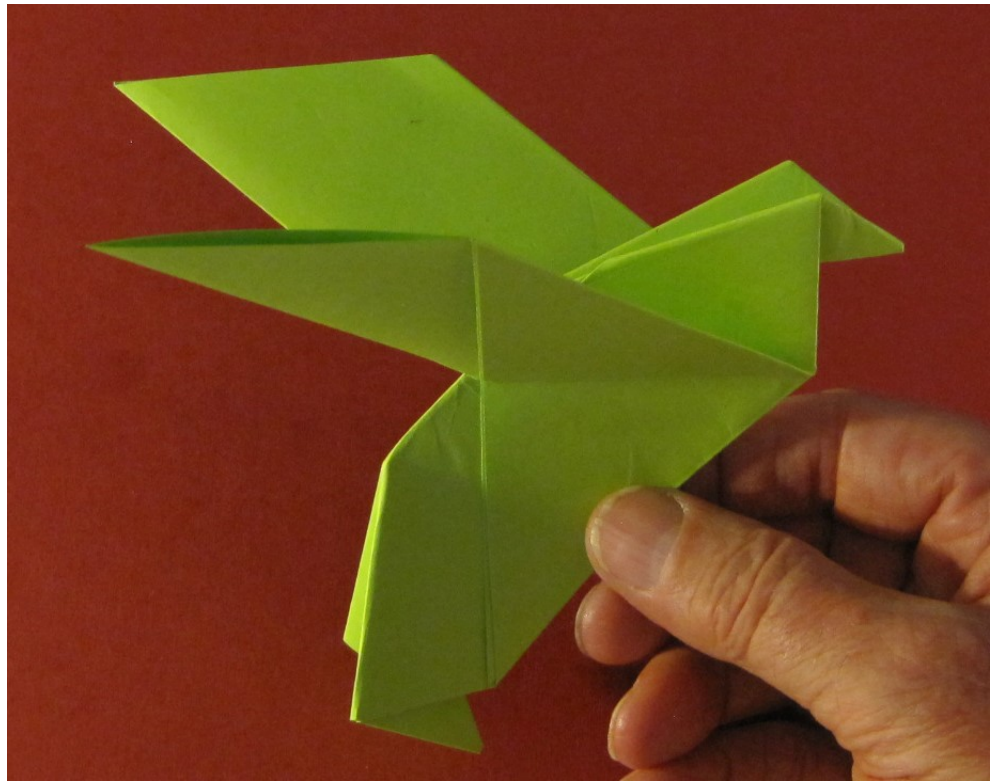
18. Fold part of tail up and down. Then push in



19. Now Swap Roles

Your dove is finished.

Now swap roles and the reader will make a dove while the other person reads. Go back to the beginning and let the second person start from the beginning.



20. Decorate your doves
